*A **Quincho**, in the culture of South American countries (specifically, in the Argentine context), is a space or a place in a building specially equipped and designed for preparing and eating grilled meals and for gatherings with family and friends. The name comes from the characteristics of its construction, as these spaces are often covered with a simple roof, tile, thatch, or wooden shingles.*

Rules for using the facility:

1. Wood for burning in the fireplace is available for free, but only from the forest behind the fence, as well as wood lying on the ground on the property (provided it is not wood from the woodshed). A cart for transporting the wood is at your disposal.
2. Please do not use wood from the woodshed. (Our cut and dried wood is priced at 400 PLN per stacked cubic meter - terms of use are negotiable).
3. The refrigerator and washing machine in the facility are at your disposal at no additional charge.
4. The wine on the shelf is the property of the Hosts and is not for sale. A compensation fee of 50 PLN 😊 will be charged for unauthorized consumption of the wine.
5. After a successful and pleasant evening, we ask that you clean up the facility and segregate plastics.
